2. Impacts - why we need your support

Research shows LEAF Open Farm Sunday is having a genuine, positive impact on visitors. With your support, we can increase our reach and impact by encouraging more farmers to open their gates and welcome the public on to farms to discover the world of farming in June.

Here are some of LOFS 2022 impacts and visitors' take home messages:

Immediate impact:

- 85% of visitors have more trust in British farming, having visited a farm
- 79% learned something new about farming and food production
- 72% say they feel the industry is doing something to help combat Climate Change
- 49% said LOFS inspired someone in their group to consider a career in the agri-food sector.

Long term impact:

- 98% have a better understanding of what 'sustainably produced' food means
- 96% said they have a greater appreciation for, and are more connected to farming
- 91% say they are more aware of, and interested in farming issues.
- 81% said that as a result of visiting a farm, they are doing things differently.

"I have started using my local farm shop, and trying to buy only British products."

Farmer feedback:

Farmers love the opportunity to talk about what they are so proud and passionate about: British farming! For businesses with a diversification, it's a great way to reach new customers. Whether farmers take part to build community relations, promote all they do for the environment or inspire the next generation, taking part is fantastic PR for the whole farming industry.


