During her visit to the Leckford Estate which is also a LEAF Demonstration Farm, The Countess of Wessex met with Andrew Hoad, Head of Leckford and Caroline Drummond, LEAF Chief Executive. She toured the Estate's various enterprises including the dairy farm, mushroom unit, orchards, vineyard and Farm Shop and also learnt more about Leckford's extensive programme of environmental management based around LEAF's Integrated Farm Management principles.

Since the first LEAF Open Farm Sunday in 2006 over 1.8m people have visited an event. This year, farms across the country, from Cornwall to Orkney, provided young and old with an opportunity to see farming in action and learn more about the work farmers are so proud to do.

• The Leckford Estate runs to 4,000 acres, some two miles north of Stockbridge in Hampshire. It produces a wide range of foods for Waitrose including milk, poultry, mushrooms, apples, pears, cider, apple juice and flour. The Estate also runs a dairy herd of over 550 Holstein Friesians and is one of around 50 dedicated dairy farmers supplying milk into Waitrose.
