6. What is the gas that comes from animal poo called?



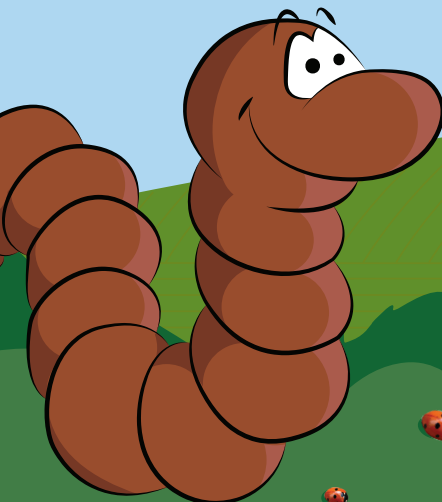
9. Which of the five words that are **bigger** than the others has the most letters in it?
